"Digitalization and Technology in Handball – Natural Sciences/The Game/Humanities"

The goal of the Conference is to bring professional and scientific experts together in order to reflect on various aspects related to professional handball but also to continue the acquisition of knowledge about medical and socio economical aspects in our sport. This year a special emphasis will be put on digitalization to discuss and elaborate the importance of technologies in sport and educational services, especially in handball, the potential it offers in defined areas and how to utilize it efficiently for handball.

The conference will be organized as a digital event.
